Astounding Third Party Results by CCGHC.

In a two-year study coordinated by the Canadian Coalition for Green Health Care (CCGHC) as part of their Safer Chemicals Project, a major Canadian health system has identified the benefits of switching from traditional cleaning products to SAO (Stabilized Aqueous Ozone).

Testing took place at one of Vancouver's **acute care hospitals** and has potential for sustainable change at eight other acute care hospitals and 23 residential care hospitals totalling over 5,000 beds. The study, funded by Environment and Climate Change Canada's EcoAction Community Funding Program was part of an overarching initiative to minimize waste generated and toxic chemicals used by the Canadian health system.
